Open Seats on Boards, Commissions and Committees:

Arts & Culture Commission - 1 seat (term ending 12/31/2022)

This seven (7) member body advises Recreation Staff and the City Council on matters pertaining to cultural and artistic activities to encourage, promote and stimulate the growth of broad-based arts in the community, and meets the 2nd Tuesday of each month at 6:30 p.m.

Housing and Neighborhood Revitalization Committee – 1 seat (term ending 12/31/2023)

This seven (7) member body acts in an advisory capacity to the Housing and Community Development Division on matters pertaining to CDBG and HTF funding including studying the needs of the Neighborhood Revitalization Strategy, and making annual recommendations for program funding awards. Meetings are held the 2nd Wednesday of each month at 6:00 p.m. in the Senior Center Meeting Room.

Library Commission – 1 seat (term ending 12/31/2024)

This five (5) member commission serves as an advisory and liaison body to the City Council, staff and the City Librarian on matters concerning the Library, and meets the 2nd Wednesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. in the Gilroy Library.

Physically Challenged Board of Appeals – 2 seats (one term ending 12/31/2023 and one term ending 12/31/2024)

This five (5) member body conducts hearings regarding enforcement of public accommodations for the physically challenged, and discusses items of interest to the physically challenged. Meetings are held at 10:00 a.m. on the 2nd Tuesday of the months of January/April/July/October.
