

The site consists of a tall one and one half story wooden residence constructed on a rectangular plan and designed in a Queen Anne cottage architectural style that is so stripped of ornament that it almost seems to be Greek Revival with slight Italianate detailing. The roofline is steeply pitched and cross gabled. The cornice line is exaggerated with moldings. Squared modillions ornament the eave above the plain frieze. The structure is sheathed in wide ship lap siding with distinctive quoins at the facade corners. Narrow colonettes ornament the projecting angled bay which is covered by small mansard roof. A narrow front porch is supported by narrow squared posts. Fenestration is simple, rectangular shaped and vertically oriented double hung windows. A multi-step straight stair leads to the front entry. The site is in good condition with minimal landscaping. A very low wall encloses the lot.
