7463 Rosanna is a cross gabled single story residential structure. A full width porch is supported by four columns and two engaged columns against the main structure. The two center posts have braces. The center gable is filled with fish scale shingles and has an opening in the center. Below the gable the entry door is flanked by rectangular window, and on each side sheathing is wide horizontal board. An addition with pitched roof is in the rear.
