This stucco bungalow has a medium gable roofline with enclosed eaves and a plain frieze. The medium gabled front porch extends from the middle of the house towards Hanna Street and has round pillars and a stucco half wall that covers the entire front side of the house. There is a breakfast nook on the south side and some fanlights on the front door.

The bungalow district in Gilroy is of architectural importance for the large number of good stylistic representations and for the interesting modifications within the bungalow design category. Gilroy was growing rapidly during the 1920's and early 30's, the era of the bungalow. A number of businesses were growing, agriculture, the farming, processing, and shipping was a very large industry and Gilroy was known as the Dairy Capital of California. The number, sizes, and designs of these bungalows represent the diversity of the community during this era.
