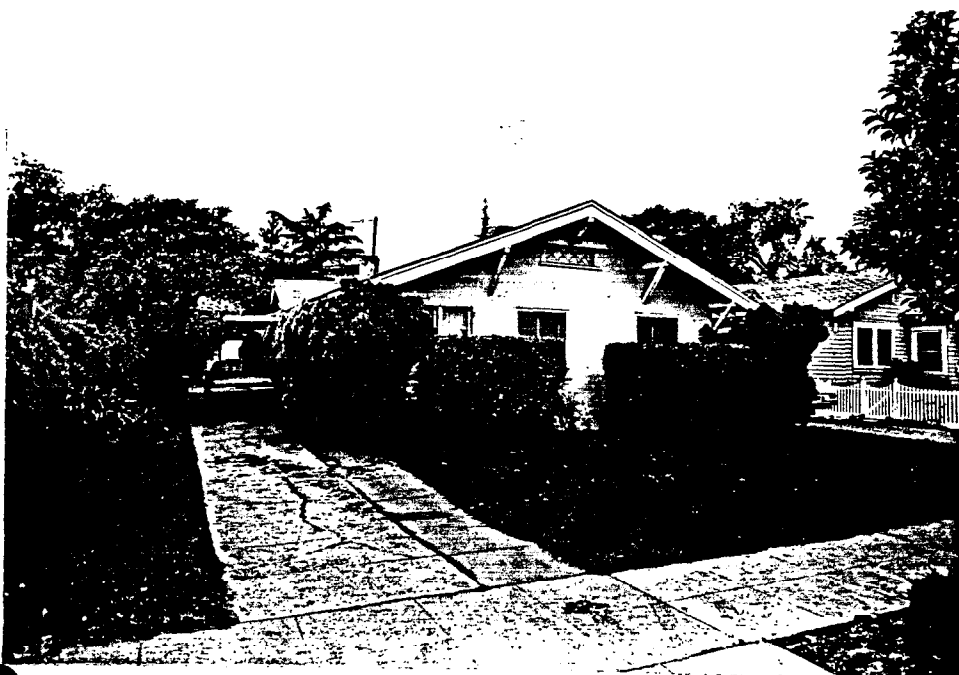

This medium gabled craftsman has the traditional latticework in the apex of the gable that serves as the signature of the builder. Other craftsman characteristics are the exposed rafters and support brackets. The walls are stucco and the main entrance is on the south side of the house instead of on the east where it would face the street.
