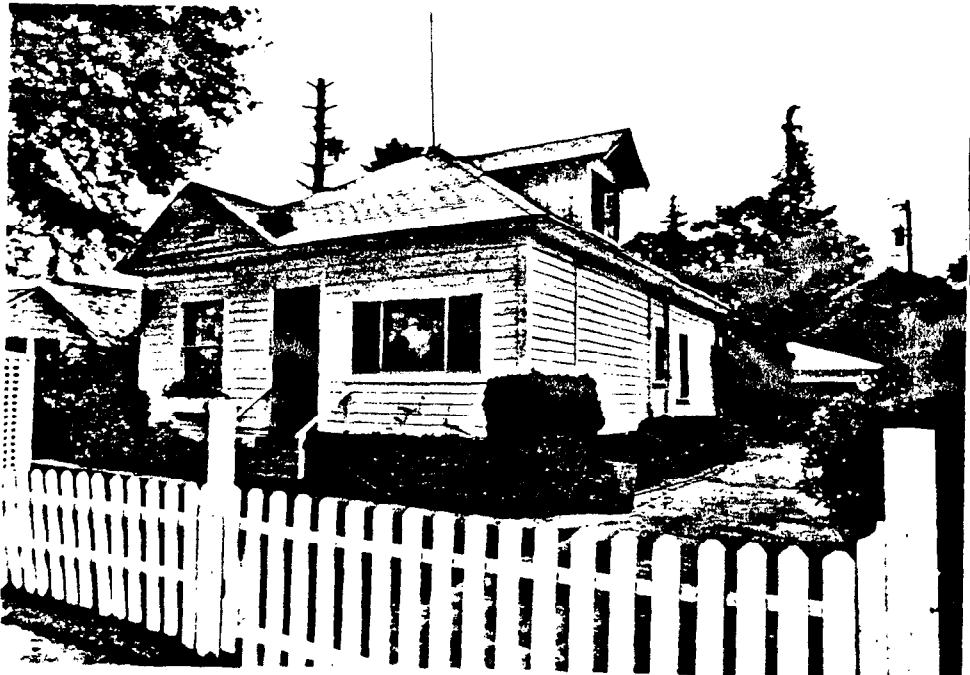

The hipped roof has a projecting offset gable decorated with shingles and a small window. The eaves are enclosed and there is a plain frieze above the wide clapboard siding. The recessed porch is supported by round columns and there are planter boxes on the porch and underneath the front window.
