

## NEW GILROY POLICE FACILITY

### Description of Project:

The Contractor is to furnishing all labor and materials as described within these contract documents to construct a one level 45,000s.f. Police Station over a 58,000 s.f. level of on-grade parking. The project is located on the south-east corner of Hanna and West Seventh Streets, bounded by Dowdy Street to the west and the Gilroy Senior Center to the north. The first floor parking garage will house a Type I Jail Facility of approximately 3,500s.f. The two-story Parking Garage/Police Station is designed as a moment-frame steel structure with a concrete unit masonry skin at the first level and plaster skin at the second level. The second story footprint is inboard of the parking garage allowing for several decks at the second level of the building. In addition to the Parking Garage/Police Station, Hanna Street between Sixth and Seventh Streets will be converted to a parking lot which will be bisected by a traffic circle. The contractor's staging area located between the project site and existing senior center will also be converted to a parking lot which will also be part of the scope of work. The entire project is to be completed within four hundred eighty (480) calendar days from the date specified in the Notice to Proceed. Time for commencement and completion of the work is important, and is to be of the essence of the Contract.
