Details

On January 22, 2011, Gilroy Police Communications received a 911 call of a home invasion style robbery that had just occurred in the 5500 block of Monterey Road, Gilroy. A responding officer observed a vehicle (occupied by Alexis Gonzales, Bustamante, Norberte, Medina & Luna) fleeing the area of the robbery. Officers conducted a “high risk” contact of the subjects – who were subsequently detained without incident. A search of the vehicle revealed items of gang indicia, the suspected stolen property and bludgeoning weapons.

The preliminary investigation revealed that the victim was confronted by an unidentified male as she walked through parking lot of the National 9 Motel. The subject began challenging the victim about possible gang affiliation. A short time later the victim observed a group of males gathering in front of her room. The subjects forced entry into the room and demanded property from the victim & two juvenile family members. The subjects fled with the victim's personal property and left the parking lot in a vehicle.

Gonzales, Bustamante, Norberte and Medina were identified as participating directly in the robbery and were arrested. Luna's participation with the robbery was not immediately clear; however Luna was arrested for the possession of a dangerous weapon. Gonzales, Bustamante, Norberte, Medina & Luna are suspected Norteno criminal street gang members.

Gonzalez, Bustamante, Norberte, Medina and Luna were booked into the Santa Clara County Main Jail.

During the evening of January 22, 2011, ACT Detectives conducted a probation search in the 9000 block of Wren Avenue (Gilroy) and in the 1000 block of San Miguel Drive (Gilroy) to further the investigation. During the parole search in the 1000 block of San Miguel Drive, Jonathan Fernandez – a suspected Norteno criminal street gang member who was recently released from prison – was arrested for a violation of his parole conditions. He was booked into the Santa Clara County Main Jail.

During the morning of January 24, 2011, ACT Detectives served a search warrant in the 200 block of Gurries Drive, Gilroy to further the investigation. During a search of the residence, Jesus Gonzalez – a suspected Norteno criminal street gang member - was arrested for the possession for sale of methamphetamine and possession for sale of marijuana. He will be booked into the Santa Clara County Main Jail.

The investigation remains active and is currently being investigated by the department's Anti-Crime Team. ACT continues to investigate ALL crimes committed by Gilroy criminal street gang members – to reduce gang violence, to reduce property & narcotic crimes which financially benefit gangs and to improve the quality of life for our community and its children.
