## Details

On 04/04/2011 at 22:36 hours Gilroy Police Officers responded to a call of shots fired into an occupied motel room at the Kings Rest Motel in Gilroy. Officers arrived and learned from the reporting party that there was a delay of about 15 minutes in calling the police. Officers discovered several rifle rounds had been fired through the front window of one of the guest rooms. Several occupants of the room fled after the shooting and three of them were later located. All three were not injured during the incident. The other occupants are still outstanding at this time but are not believed to have been injured.

The preliminary investigation revealed that two suspects were involved in the shooting; however, their identity remains unknown and only vague descriptions of their appearance could be obtained. It was determined that one of the suspects fired a rifle into the room and the weapon has not been recovered. After the shooting the suspects fled on foot to the rear of the motel. An extensive area check was done but the suspects were not located.
