

PUBLIC NOTICE
OF THE PUBLIC REVIEW PERIOD FOR THE
CITY OF GILROY 2020-2025 CONSOLIDATED PLAN
AND FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council at their June 1, 2020 meeting will receive public comments on the 2020-2025 Consolidated Plan, and provide direction on funding allocations for the proposed Fiscal Year (FY) 2020-2021 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Housing Trust Fund (HTF) programs.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the City Council at their June 15, 2020 meeting will consider adoption of the 2020-2025 Consolidated Plan and FY 2020-2021 Annual Action Plan.

PUBLIC REVIEW PERIOD: A 30-day public review period will begin on May 15, 2020 and end on June 15, 2020 for the Draft 2020-2025 Consolidated Plan and FY 2020-2021 Annual Action Plan. Comments received during the review period and at these public hearings will be listed and addressed in the final version of these documents to be submitted for approval by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

Under federal law, the City of Gilroy, as an entitlement recipient of CDBG funds, is required to submit a five-year Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plans to HUD, listing priorities and strategies for the use of its federal funds. The 2020-2025 Consolidated Plan was created with the coordination and efforts between the City of Gilroy, County of Santa Clara Office of Supportive Housing, and various local jurisdictions across Santa Clara County.

The Draft Annual Action Plan describes the CDBG activities and City funding plans for the period of July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021. The City is expected to receive \$468,300 in FY 2020-2021 CDBG entitlement funds, plus an estimated \$27,000 in prior year program income for a total of \$495,300 in available CDBG funds.

In addition, approximately \$200,800 in grant funding is expected to be available from the local Housing Trust Fund for housing and homeless related public services. These activities are proposed to align with the policy goals and objectives of the Housing Trust Fund set forth by the Gilroy City Council, and address Gilroy's affordable housing and community development objectives described in the City's 2020-2025 Consolidated Plan.
