

## Continued Work and Safety

Occasional work activity will occur on W. Luchessa Ave. after the pipeline is installed. Lane closures will be necessary, but roads will remain open to allow vehicles to travel in both directions.

Emergency vehicles will continue to have access during the lane closure of identified streets. Valley Water and its contractor will ensure nearby streets remain safe for students, pedestrians, bicyclists and local traffic. Extensive safety traffic control measures will be implemented. Please use caution when driving near the construction area and follow all traffic control measures.

Once the South County Recycled Water Pipeline Project is completed, the distribution of additional recycled water service will be expanded for existing customers, delivery will be improved to allow for service to new customers, and the updated pipeline will be able to support future system expansion.

Thank you for your understanding throughout the duration of this project.

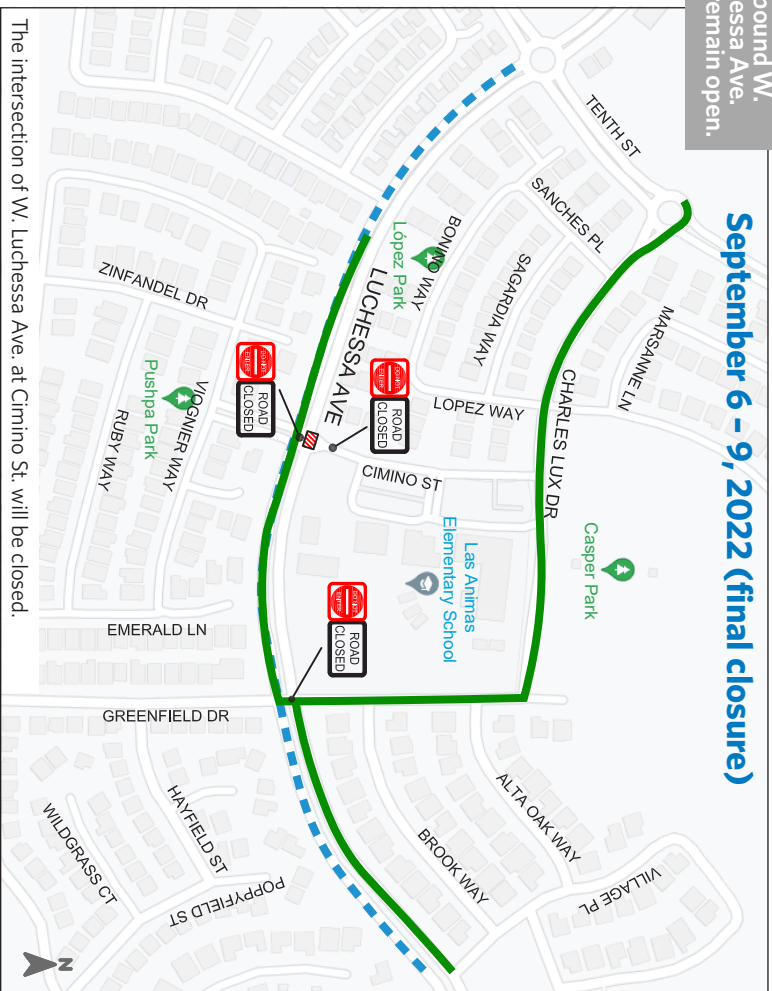
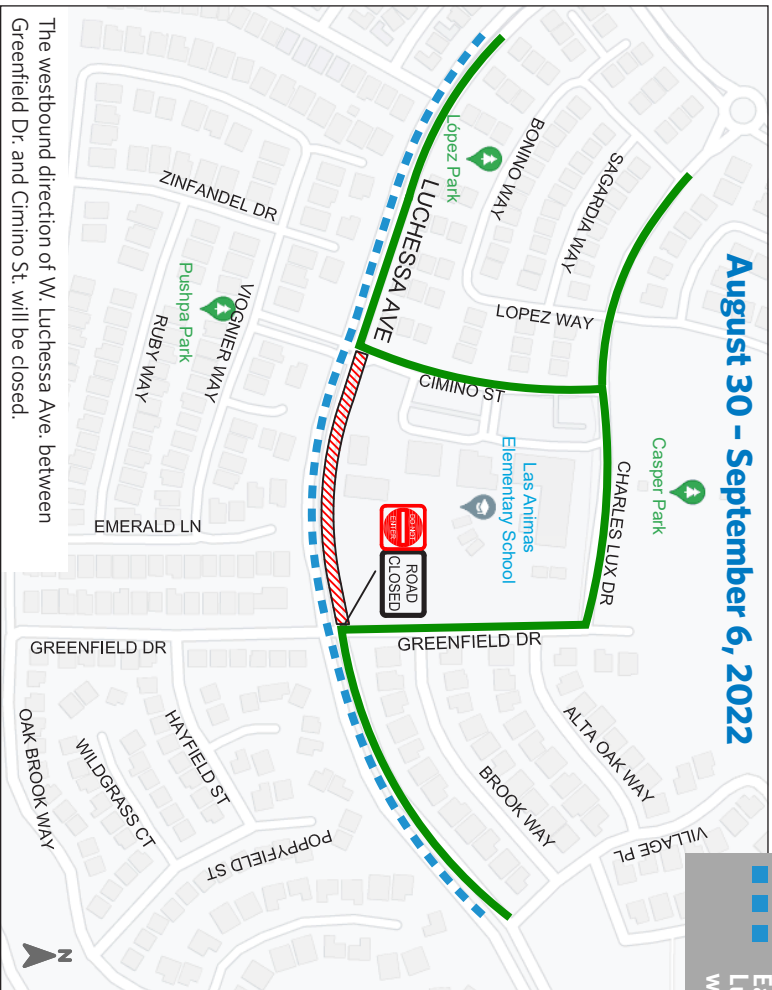
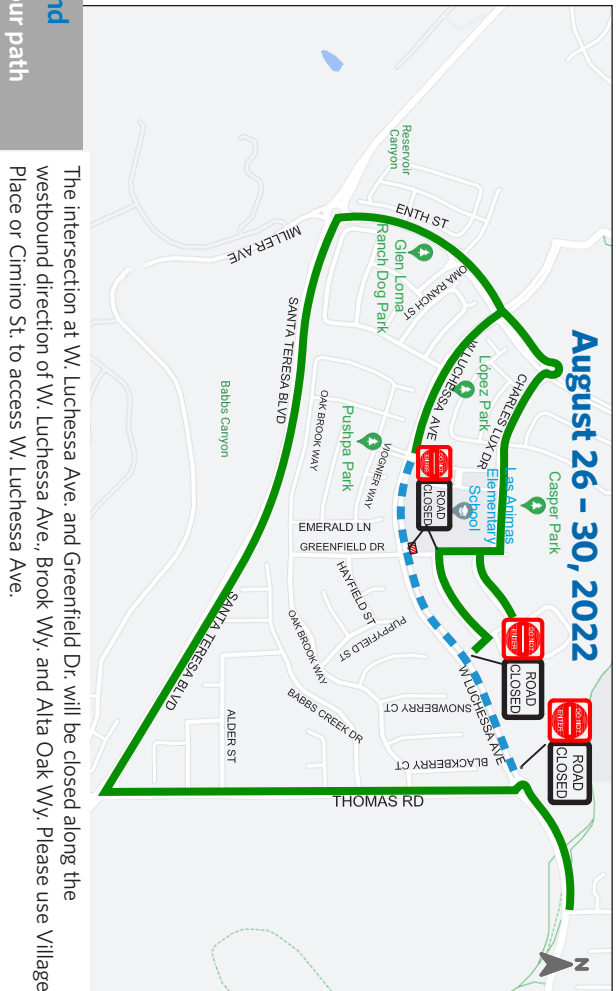
Valley Water's work on the South County Recycled Water Pipeline Project is progressing. Our crews will reopen Luchessa Bridge by **August 9, 2022**. Thank you for your continued patience with our pipeline work and upcoming traffic impacts.

There will be four more scheduled detours on W. Luchessa Ave. beginning in August 2022. They will impact commuters traveling westbound, between Thomas Rd. and Cimino St. The eastbound direction of W. Luchessa Ave. will remain open during these final phases of our construction activities.

The detour maps and anticipated work schedule for the remaining sections of W. Luchessa Ave. are listed inside this mailer. The dates may shift by a couple of days due to the availability of pipeline materials or unforeseen work related delays.
