“The BRC”

- 230-bed congregate shelter serving single adults
- Light-touch case management provided by Resident Advocates
- TVs and computers w/internet for guest use
- Mail services
- Multiple programs available:
 - 60-day (with possible extensions)
 - New Start for guests interested in learning kitchen or janitorial skills
 - Working Person’s Program for employed guests
 - Veteran’s, VHHP, and Behavioral Health beds



Sunnyvale Shelter



- 142-bed congregate shelter for single adults and families
- 120-day stay with potential extensions
- Full-time case management services, including evening and weekend hours
- TVs and computers w/internet for guest use
- Onsite guest storage available

Gilroy Shelter

- 100-bed congregate shelter for single adults and families
- Onsite case management services through the South County Compassion Center
- A television and basketball hoop for guest use
- Onsite guest storage available
