- 7b. Briefly describe the present *physical appearance* of the site or structure and describe any major alterations from its original condition:

The site is a slightly more ornamented Queen Anne Cottage style single family residence. The building is designed in a general rectangular plan with moderately pitched cross gables. The original exterior walls are sheathed in wide ship lap. Fenestration is simple and general rectangular in shape and double hung. A sunburst adds ornament to the pedimented street facade gable. Barge board adds further detail. Various alterations have been added to the structure including aluminum door frame, some exterior wall construction and the cyclone fence surrounding the lot. Landscape is mature and somewhat overgrown.
