This square form one and a half story structure has a number of design elements relating to its 100 years. The raised porch has a low wall sheathed in narrow clapboard. Four square columns support the porch roof. In the high hipped roof, a tall gable becomes almost a dormer with multiple shingle patterns and a center window. The remainder of the structure is classic center entrance balanced window pattern of the early 1880's.
