# Food Pantry

The Salvation Army Gilroy Community Center provides food to more than 250 families per month. We offer free, fresh produce, bread, eggs, and dairy items, we try provide valuable meal supplementation while helping those in need to maintain their independence and dignity.



# Hot Meal Program

We are currently serving 500 meals per month. Our Monday to Friday sit-down meal program provides nutritious food and valuable human interaction. These meals are served to anyone in need, this includes unhoused people of all ages, as well as individuals and families in need of a helping hand. We also deliver meals to those who cannot reach our Community Center, we ensure that the most vulnerable members of society in our community do not go hungry.





## Fresh Produce Program

Thanks to our partnership with Second Harvest Food Bank, we receive beautiful fresh fruits and vegetables and distribute to a total of 780 local families (3800 individuals) per month. Our weekly food program allows us to serve and connect with the community on a more regular basis.

Depending on the size of the family, each box contains around 10 different fresh items.
