Good Neighbor Encampment Crews

- Valley Water has two Good Neighbor encampment crews who service over 294 miles of creeks, which is only 1/3 of creeks county wide.
- Services these crews provide are enhanced encampment cleanups, removal of trash and debris, removal of abandoned encampments and abatement cleanups.
- In 2023 the Good Neighbor crews removed over 71 tons of trash and debris from creeks in Gilroy.
- There are currently 68 active encampments along Valley Water property in Gilroy.
- Our next clean up in Gilroy is scheduled for 1/29/24-1/31/2024

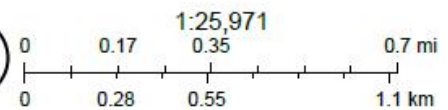
